Sparkling Wines

- \$50** **BIN# 34 La Luca Prosecco**
Rich and creamy, off dry with a touch of minerality.
- \$165** **BIN# 52 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut Champagne**
The palate is plump and flavorsome with plenty of berries and citrus
- \$50** **BIN# 61 Gerard Bertrand Cote des Roses, Rose, Languedoc 2024**
Floral notes of rose, a hint of grapefruit, very fresh with a hint of candy on the finish.

White Wines

- \$70** **BIN# 194 Whitehaven, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2023**
Hints of grapefruit, white peach, pineapple, and juicy pear. Superbly structured and balanced with a clean, zesty finish
- \$100** **BIN# 148 Jordan Chardonnay, Russian River 2021 (4)**
Flavors of juicy citrus, Asian pear and lemon peel balance seamlessly with the subtle French oak notes.
- \$90** **BIN# 157 Rombauer Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California 2023**
Flavors of lychee and yellow peach which meld perfectly with the cream texture, vanilla and slight butter.
- \$50** **BIN# 1053 Duckhorn Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley 2023, WE 91**
This wine is vibrant, with aromas of Meyer lemon, green papaya and lemongrass on the nose. The flavors on the palate are white nectarine, orange sherbet and allspice.

Red Wines

- \$70** **BIN# 201 Prisoner Pinot Noir, Napa Valley 2021 (5) 2022 (6)**
Persistent flavors of ripe raspberry, boysenberry, pomegranate and vanilla, smooth and luscious finish.
- \$100** **BIN# 265 Flowers Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, 2023/ JS 93**
Medium-to full-bodied with fine, well-integrated tannins. Fresh acidity and bright, juicy fruit on the palate. Well balanced.
- \$175** **BIN# 423 Passing Time "Olde Farm Cabernet" Columbia Valley 2018**
The dark fruit elements carry onto the palate, with deeply concentrated dark berry reduction, candied currants, black forest cake, and hints of mocha
- \$60** **BIN# 425 The Big Red Monster Cabernet Paso Robles NV / WE 90**
Palate amplifies that herbal edge, with rich milk-chocolate and black-fruit flavors.
- \$140** **BIN# 903 Domaine Serene Evanstad Reserve "Olde Farm", Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley 2014 / WS 94**
Notes of coffee, smoke, black fruits, a touch of charred wood all worked through.
